Venue

The seminars, clinics, exams, and tournament will be held at the Richmond Olympic Oval at 6111 River Road. Signage within the building will direct you to our karate events and registration desk, which are all within Courts 12 and 13 on the northwest side of the facility.

Hotel

The Sheraton Vancouver Airport Hotel is the official tournament hotel. It is located at 7551 Westminster Highway in Richmond, and is only 10 minutes walking distance to the tournament/seminar venue (Olympic Oval), and is close to the Sky Train terminal, which goes to the Airport and Downtown Vancouver.

The ISKF World Shoto Cup is open to all ISKF Canada members of all ages (children, adults, and seniors). In this information session, the ISKF Canada Technical Director or delegate will be collecting contact information from members who are interested in participating in the upcoming ISKF World Shoto Cup.

Banquet

All athletes must wear a white karate gi and those competing in the kumite division must wear a mouth guard and approved white fist protectors.

Opening Ceremonies

All judges (in uniform) and competitors (in gi) are requested to attend the opening ceremonies on Saturday, May 18 at 1pm. Please arrive by 12:30pm to be staged for a march-in ceremony.

Youth Invitational Tournament Events

The Youth Invitational Tournament is occurring on Saturday, which is open to ISKF members from Canada and the USA that are aged 17 and under. This event will include categories for kata and kumite, including a demonstration category for shobu-ippō (free-sparring) for some kyu level categories. In order to compete in the demonstration category, competitors must compete in their traditional kumite division as well. **The below chart represents the approximate categories that will be offered, with a note that male and female divisions may be combined or separated (when appropriate) dependent on the number of registrants.**
